
Standard of the Week, February 6—10 (Week 6)

- At least 1 photo per month, with indicator label attached
- Meaningful, interesting work samples, with indicator labels attached
- Up--to-date assessment checklists (both sides!)
- Personal goals, with follow up noted

Please store all checklists in portfolios only (not on clipboards or elsewhere) so the most up-to-date info is always available to parents. Families understand that assessment is work in progress.
