<u>HWT Recommendations Regarding Numbers</u> - "Treat numbers separately from your letter handwriting instruction. Integrate number formation with your math or other instruction. Numbers share all the same characteristics of print capitals, so we suggest that you use the same methods when you teach them. Follow numeric order because one through seven all start in the starting corner (top left) while eight, nine, and zero start in different spots at the top."

Based on this recommendation, you will find number formation in your math lesson plans, beginning in Unit 2.
